Eligibility Criteria

1. Must meet one of these categories:
 - a. ALANA Background
 - b. Family Member or Community Member with a System Involved Background
 - c. Non-traditional College Student

AND

2. Student attending Lebanon Valley College
3. Must attend college full-time (minimum of 12 credits)
4. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
5. Financial need

2. A 500-word minimum essay stating the need for the funds.
