

Master of Science in Clinical Mental Health Counseling

INSTRUCTIONAL MODALITIES

The program utilizes a mix of instructional modalities: 1/3 of the curriculum involves a combination of face-to-face and online experiences while the remaining 2/3 of coursework is entirely online.

SCHEDULING FORMATS

All graduate courses at LVC are delivered in an accelerated format, with individual classes offered in a 7-week course structure; this leads to six terms per year (Fall I and II, Spring I and II, and Summer I and II). All courses in the CMHC program carry 3 credits. Students with an appropriate bachelor's degree can pursue the program full- or part-time; full-time students can complete the program in two years, while part-time students could graduate in three or more years.
