One-Year-Out Alumni Survey Class of 2013

This survey was administered to the graduates of the class of 2013 beginning on May 1st. Alumni were first sent a web invited followed by email reminders. They were then sent a paper survey in June and received a final web follow-up from Career Services in August. The College had email or mail addresses for all alumni from the class of 2013. Of the 309 class of 2013 graduates, 140 completed the survey for a response rate of 45.3%.
