


Apple VPN Connection for OSX Sierra

1. Choose Apple menu > System Preferences, then click Network.
2. Click the Add button + in the list at the left, click the Interface pop-up menu, then choose VPN.
 - a. VPN Type – L2TP/IPsec
 - b. Service Name – LVC
 - c. Select Create



Select the interface and enter a name for the new service.


