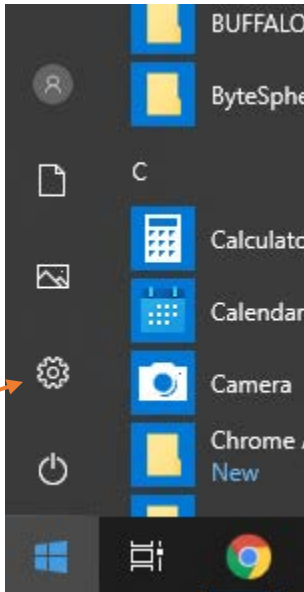
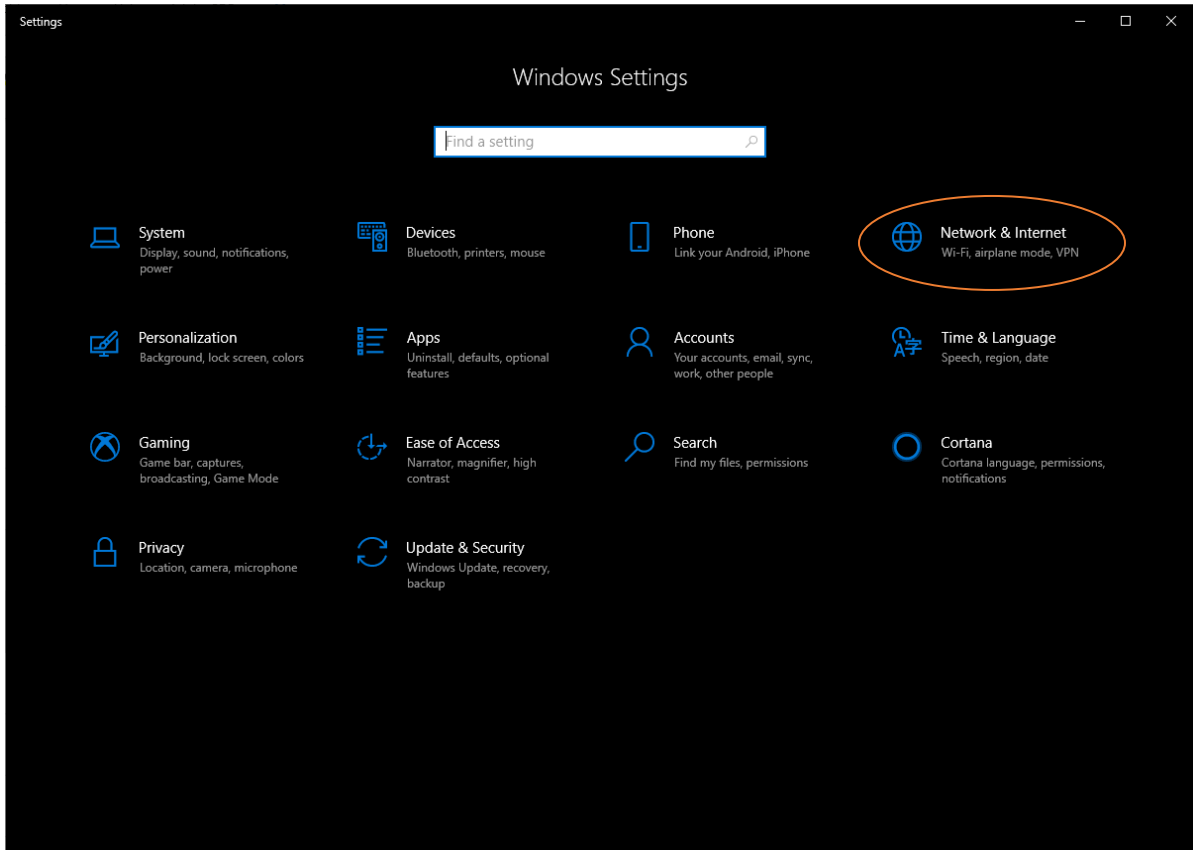


LVC VPN Setup Instructions for Windows 10

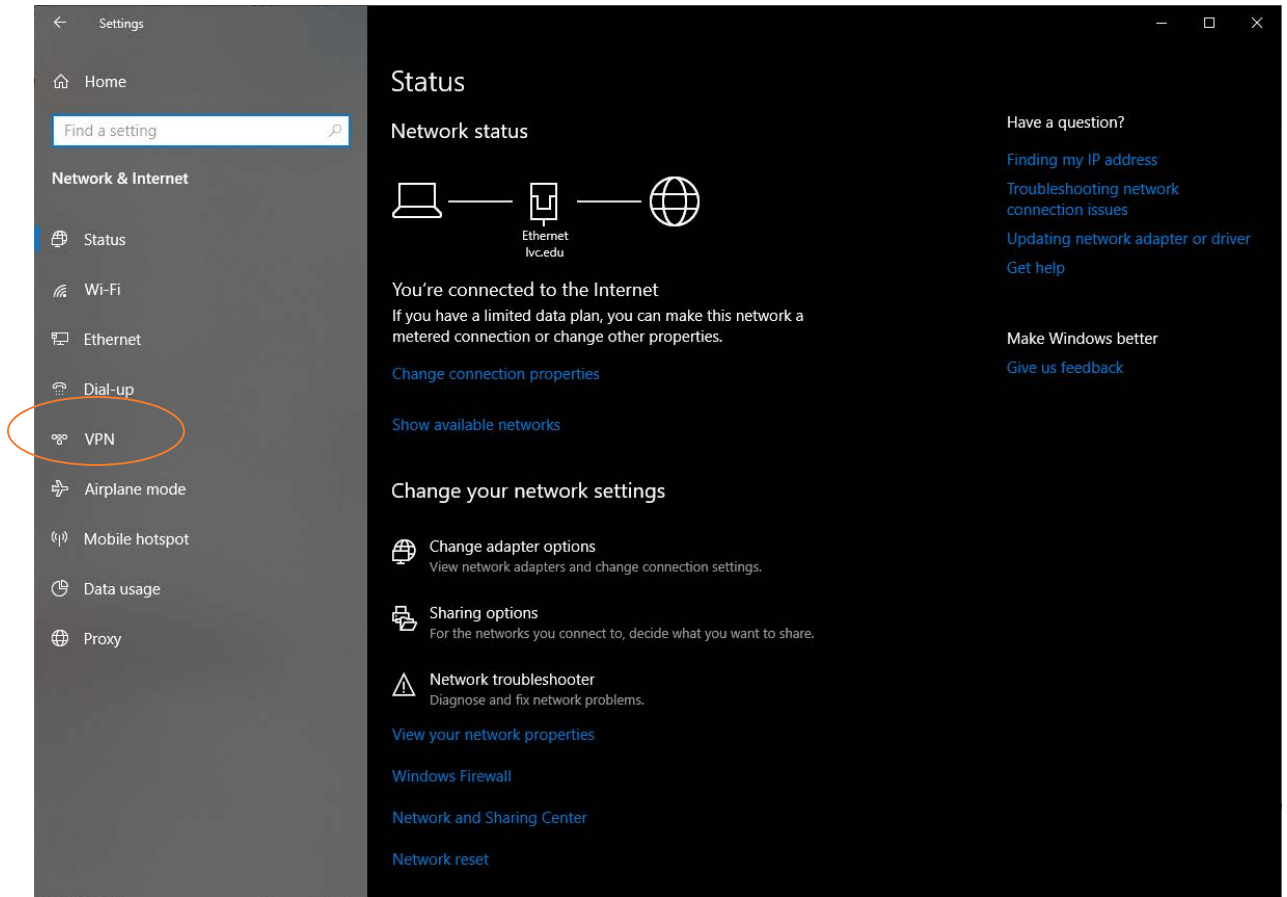
1. Click on the Start Menu -> Click the settings icon




2. In the Windows Settings menu, select Network and Internet



3. On left side of the new menu select “VPN”:



4. Select "Add VPN" and fill out the field like below and click save:

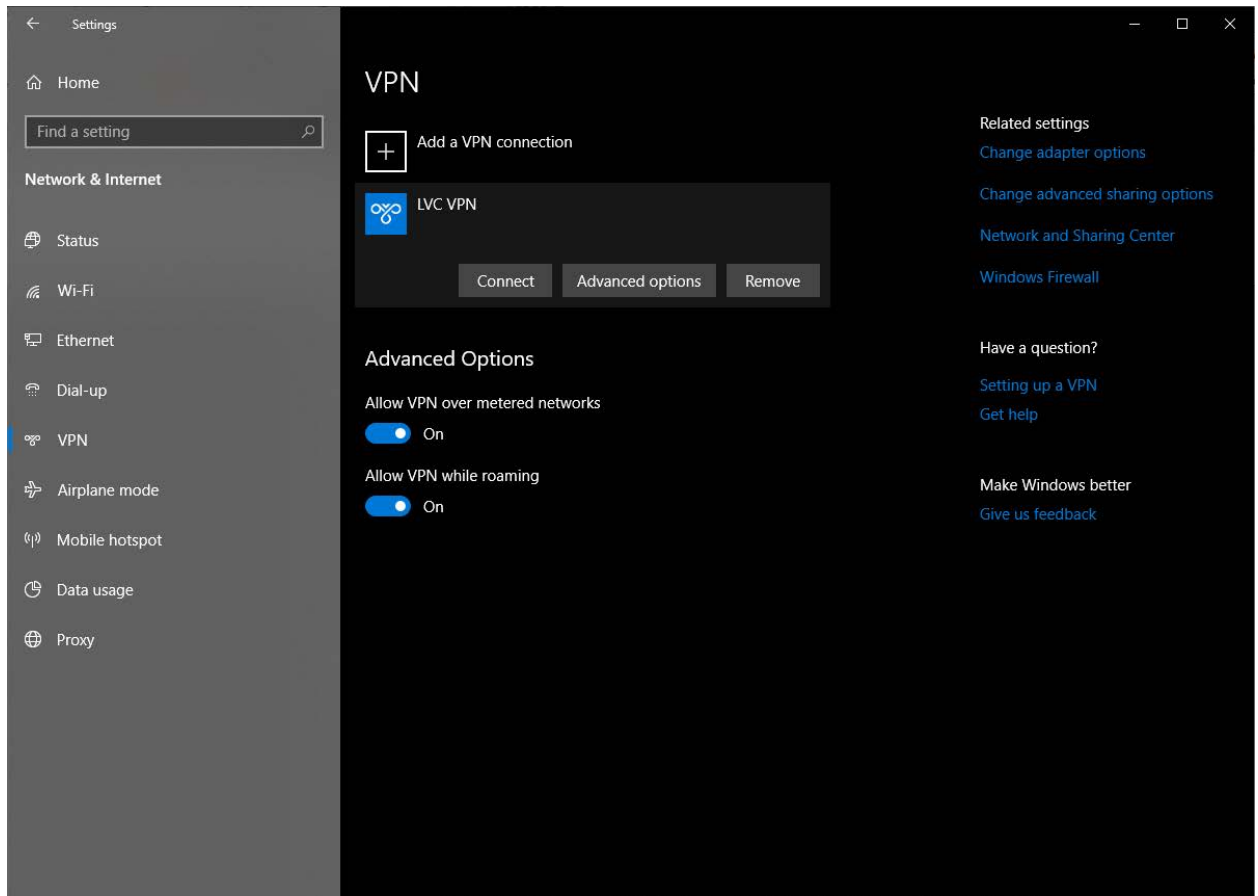

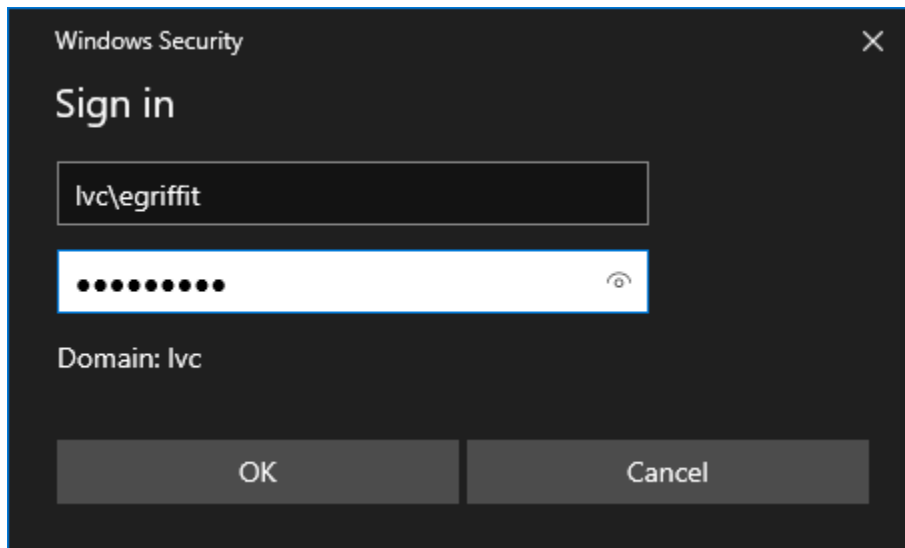

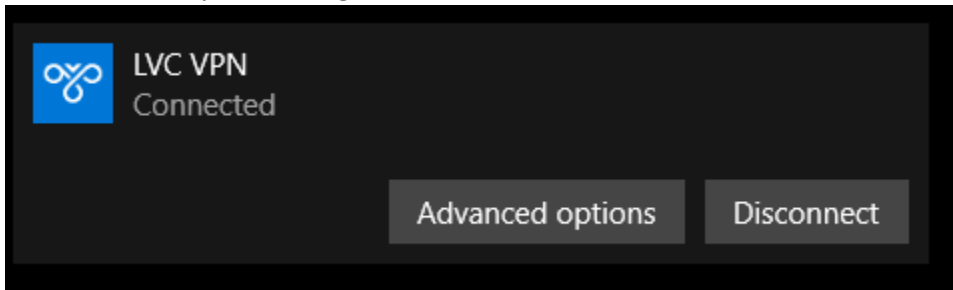
5. You should now see a connection called “LVC VPN” in the VPN menu, click this connection and select “Connect”



6. When prompted for Username/Password enter in the format like below (lvc\[username]) and click ok:



7. After successfully connecting the connection should look like below:



At this time you should be able to access any on campus resources as if your computer was connected on campus

8. To disconnect the VPN connection, click disconnect. **Please only remain connected when necessary to access your LVC resources, as the server could becoming overloaded with too many unnecessary connections.**
